Dear Friends,

It's challenging to be a Christian and particularly challenging to be a Catholic Christian. It really isn't easy to do what's right when doing what is right isn't a popular thing to do. It seems to me that often it is far easier to go along with the crowd and accept things as just the way things are.

When the crowd shouted "Hosanna", we shouted "Hosanna". When the crowd screamed, "Crucify him", we screamed "Crucify him". The history of our Church, from the time of Jesus to the present day, has been filled and continues to be filled by the witness of saints and martyrs who didn't accept the social and personal sins of their times as just "the ways things are" but instead followed the way of Jesus. Many of them in the sure and certain knowledge that this was the way to their martyrdom. Sadly, in society, too many of us are easily swept into the fear and hatred of the crowd, and are willing to unleash our anger on the most convenient innocent victim.

However, despite the challenges of our faith, we are not called to accept abuse, whether physical, spiritual, or psychological, but we are called to speak out against abuse and stand with those who are abused. This is the way of the Cross, the way of Christ.

The current events in Ukraine vividly inform us that there is still war and there are still refugees. Here in the UK there is still racism, and all around us, there are those who are economically disadvantaged. Despite these challenges we must carry the cross that Jesus has given us and we must resist the temptation to go along with the crowd.
