Dear Brothers and sisters,

Christos Anesti, Alleluia! - Alithos Anesti, Alleluia! Christ is Risen, Alleluia! - He is truly Risen, Alleluia!

This was, and still is in some parts of the world, the greeting among Christians during the "Fifty Days" of Easter. Last week, as we gathered to celebrate the "Vigil of Vigils," the "Night of Nights", the Easter Liturgy entertained us with a host of amazing images to describe the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ from the dead: Vanquishing satan and the grave; Bursting his three day prison; Conquering the shameful tree; Harrowing hell. Unless we personally share in this victory of Christ, and unless we experience the power of the resurrection in our own lives, these powerful images will remain only images. And all images, as we know, fade rather quickly. That is why the Risen Lord comes and appears over and over during these "Fifty Days" to seek out all those among us who long to share his Pass-over from death to life, from slavery to freedom, from darkness to light, from despair to hope, from any "foreign country" to the Promised Land.

Like on Resurrection Sunday, also today "Dawn tinges the sky with purple, the sound of praise echoes in the air. The world rejoices in triumph, hell trembles with fear: while the King, Christ, frees mankind from the dark prison of death and leads us to life. Christ triumphs with glory and wakes from death: no more mourning, no weeping, no more sorrows. He rose from death!"

And it is in this spirit that Fr Chris and I thank you for your many greetings and very generous offerings. We wish you and your families every happiness and peace during these days of Eastertide. And we assure all the sick and housebound of our parish, that they are not forgotten. May the Peace of the Risen Christ console your heart.
