Godwin (my husband) and I have recently returned from two weeks in the South of Italy. Although it was planned as simply a holiday, it turned out to be much more than that. Together with Godwin's cousin and wife we had hired a car, and looked forward to seeing the sights of the provinces of Puglia and Basilicata. Of course, the excellent food, wine and beaches were also eagerly anticipated – and we were not disappointed!

Several churches, cathedrals and basilicas were also on our itinerary, but our trip was made for recreation, rather than as a pilgrimage to holy sites. However, as is often the case, what we planned was not what we received: as the famous saying goes, if you want to make God laugh, tell him your plans!

In our case, this came in the form of an unexpected and acute illness which meant an over-night stay in hospital was required. This, and the necessary convalescence and taking of medication (no more local wines!) were rude interruptions to our fun.

However, the experience of this became an integral part of the trip. It made us all aware of how fragile our grasp upon life is. Each day is a gift, and the sheer gratuity of health and the simple things we enjoy – walking, seeing, eating, swimming – adds to their savour, and does not diminish it. But this is true in the fullest sense when we remember where and in Whom our life really exists.

Today's readings and Gospel reminded me of this. The parable of the rich man who plans for the future, unmindful of his own impending death illustrates Jesus' warning to the man who asks for a worldly inheritance. As he says, '*a man's life is not made secure by what he owns.*' St Paul expresses more fully what this means for us who are followers of Jesus:

*'Since you have been brought back to true life in Christ, you must look for the things that are in heaven, where Christ is.'*
