Bob travelled to work every day on the train. He had his usual seat (lucky him) and for as long as he could remember the same man sat opposite him every day. Bob felt he knew this man, from the way he dressed Bob guessed he has a nice office in the city and that he worked nine to five. He knew the type of books he liked to read and he figured he knew what political party he supported from the papers he read. He assumed he had family from the picture he spotted in his wallet one day. Although the two commuters often nodded to each other they never spoke or knew each other names.

One day the train ground to a halt, there had been an accident on the line and all trains were delayed. There were the usual general announcements by the train company but no real news about the accident. Everyone became a little agitated and began to speculate about what might have happened. Bob leaned over, reached out his hand to his fellow commuter and said "Hi, I'm Bob". His fellow commuter took his hand and said "Hi, I'm Jim".

In that moment the relationship changed. Bob had known a certain amount about Jim, but he could never have said he knew him. Now as they chatted he began to get to know him but if Bob had not taken the initiative they would have remained strangers.

In today's Gospel Jesus put this question to the disciples, "who do people say the Son of Man is?". People had all sorts of theories about Jesus, who he might be and what was his mission. The disciples appeared a little shocked at the question and all sort of answers came gushing out. Peter, not known to be the brightest of the disciples, suddenly has a moment of revelation, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God". Now Peter knew a lot of things about Jesus, like the two men on the train they had been observing each other for years. However, this step that Peter takes in proclaiming the he understands Jesus as the Son of God can be nothing short of a gift from God.

If we reach out, offer our hand to God and begin a conversation with him, he will, when the time is right, reveal himself to us. Faith is a gift from God, if you have faith pray to deepen that faith, if you are just on nodding terms with God but would like to reach out your hand and get to know him better then perhaps you would like to join the Faith Formation course that starts on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September at 7pm.
