Dear Friends,

In every parish there are people who have visions. But I sincerely hope you are not one of them! Some priests treat these people with great patience and kindness – even if they think they are absolutely nuts. Other priests give them short shrift. You can imagine what happens in this parish, can't you?

I've read somewhere that one-day an old woman told her parish priest about the wonderful vision that she was having. But the priest, a hard case, demanded some kind of proof. "*The next time God appears to you*", he said, "*ask him to tell you about my sins, which are known only to him, and then I might just believe you.*" The old woman returned some time later, and the priest asked her: "*did you ask God to tell you about my sins?*" "*I most certainly did*", the old woman replied. "*And what did God reveal to you?*" the priest asked. The old woman looked the priest straight in the eyes, and answered; "*God said, tell your priest I have completely forgotten all his sins.*"

Wow! That was a true vision, if ever there was one. And old women who have visions like that should be welcome in every parish. They are certainly most welcome here by me! Why? Because it is just possible that all the terrible things I have done in the past have been forgotten by everyone - but not forgotten by me! All of us have a litany of regrets: things we regret having done or said. Or things we regret not having done or said. But it is too late now. Sometimes we think the irrevocable has happened.

But there is **Good News!** Every Sunday we meet the old woman who had that vision. At Mass, however, this old woman is old no longer. No! Now she is young and beautiful. She is the Church! Assuring us that God, who does not remember our sins, gives us another chance, and another Listen to the Gospel! We find Peter who was admired and blessed by Jesus and then few minutes later the same Jesus calls him being of *scandal* like "*Satan*". Strange? No! This is the Truth: if God doesn't keep always his hand on our head and assure us of his forgiveness and grace we cannot go far. Therefore, let us believe this Good News, because in your life and mine, nothing is irrevocable. Nothing! God knows what we deserve and truly need. May God bless you and your family.
