Jesus and his friends rowed across the lake to find a quiet place to rest.

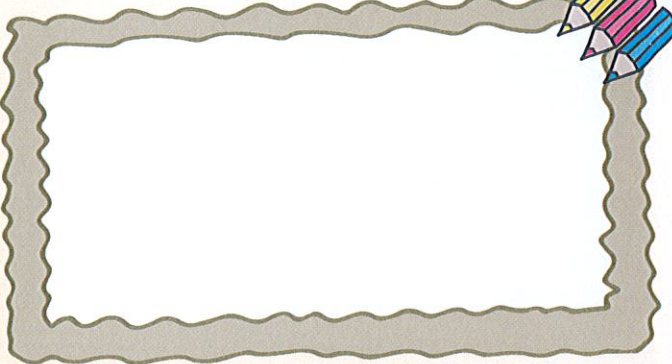


Which beach should they land on?
