**LAST CALL FOR ANYONE WISHING TO GO TO LOURDES, there is still time to book a place.** Dates: **23<sup>rd</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> July**. On the way to Lourdes we will be visiting the shrine of the Sacred Heart in Paray le Monial and on the return journey we will be stopping in Poitiers and Lisieux – the shrine of St Therese. Price £699 per person based on two sharing plus insurance £35.00, single room supplement £199 per person. Price includes full board whilst in Lourdes and half board at stops on route.
