Advent is a season of preparation for Christmas. But to understand Christmas we have to start at the beginning, with the history of our salvation.

God's plan of salvation is centred in Jesus and realised through Him. Advent looks back at the promise of his first coming, when the plan was announced, and it looks forward to his second coming when His plan will be fulfilled. It also celebrates Jesus' actual coming in time.

Let us pray this week for those people who find life difficult at this time of year as a result of bereavement, illness, worries or sadness:
