# My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

It is coming! And much sooner than usual! Today, the Second Sunday of Advent, the whole Church set out on the path to Christmas. Our first "resting place" on this journey will be the "Twelve Days of Christmas". So we are in preparation: ADVENT! All during Advent we shall be faced with a big temptation. What is it? It is the temptation to anticipate Christmas instead of preparing for it. It is the temptation to celebrate Christmas before Christmas has arrived.

In Oxford Street the Herald Angels are already singing - with competition from Rudolf the Red-Nosed Reindeer - not to mention Bing Crosby! In Regent Street, unable to wait for the Feast of Stephen, Good King Wenceslaus is already looking out, even if the snow is not "round about"! Even here in Feltham we can feel the echo of Christmas carols.

Unfortunately, many people will be sick and tired of all things Christmassy, well before 25<sup>th</sup> December arrives. For these people, the true celebration of Christmas, and the twelve days leading to the feast of the Epiphany, will be dull and flat. During these days they will be trying to recover from the very thing they should be celebrating! I hope you and I will not be among them. Therefore, LET US WAIT!

The Church invites us to have a sense of timing quite different from that of Marks & Spencer, John Lewis, Tesco or Asda! Those who do not fast do not feast. Those who do not prepare do not really celebrate. Those who do not wait do not arrive. So let us keep the Advent spirit, the Advent discipline. It will reap a rich harvest. Let us learn to wait and desire, to yearn and long. Let us prepare well, not anticipate. When the great feast arrives, our joy will be great, very great indeed, the joy of a Happy Christmas.

Therefore as we wait, let us offer our fervent prayer to the one who intercedes before God, our Immaculate Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary. May she help us to celebrate with faith the Birth of the Lord so close at hand. May God bless you all.

#### AN OPEN AIR PASSION PLAY IN STAINES - EASTER 2014

Churches Together have a thrilling opportunity; to declare Christ's trial, death and resurrection in a vivid, open-air play that will be both a stunning visual spectacle and an arresting and thought-provoking drama. Our passion play will be the same as the acclaimed Wintershall 'Passion Play' which has been performed most notably over recent years in Trafalgar Square where it attracts huge crowds. We will stage our drama in the Memorial Gardens in Staines, in the open air, on **Easter Saturday**, 19th April 2014. There will be two performances, at midday and 2.30, each running for about 90 minutes.
