

### THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD - THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

**Introduction:** Today we hear about John the Baptist, who came to tell everyone to get ready for Jesus who is the light of the world. Let's think about what that means.

**Opening Prayer:** God of light, you sent your Son into the world to guide us and show us how to live. Help us to follow his example by loving and caring for others. Amen

**Gospel:** John 1:6-8, 19-28 – “God sent his messenger, a man named John, who came to tell people about the light, so that all should hear the message and believe. He himself was not the light, he came to tell us about the light”.

**Gospel Reflection:** At the beginning it talks a lot about the light. The light is another name for someone very special. Can you think who that might be?

Jesus is the light of the world. This reading says that John the Baptist came to tell everyone Jesus was coming.

Why do you think Jesus is called the light of the world? Jesus is the Son of God and he shows us how we should live – he is a shining light in the darkness for us to follow.

**Bidding Prayers:** John the Baptist asks us to get ready for Jesus and so we pray together for God's help.

We pray for all people around the world who are preparing to celebrate the birth of Jesus: that we may not forget those who need our help at this special time. *Lord in your mercy ...*

We pray for all people who are poor, hungry, sick or alone: that they may be filled with the joy and peace of Christ. *Lord in your mercy ...*

We pray for our parish community, family and friends: that we may be kind and generous to others as we prepare for the coming of Christ. *Lord in your mercy..*

**Closing Prayer:** Generous God, as we prepare for the coming of your Son Jesus, help us to remember all our brothers and sisters in our global family and to share your love with them. Amen

#### Blessing: Prayer for the light of the world:

God of light, shine brightly, show us how to bring hope to others.

God of mercy help us to comfort people and to share their joy.

God of hope help us this Advent to share your light with others.

Amen

We light the 3<sup>rd</sup> Candle today. Like John the Baptist we are called to be light bearers, to carry Jesus' love and light to those we meet in our daily lives.

As we celebrate this season of Advent may we grow in hopefulness and gratitude and may the light of Jesus shine brighter than this winter darkness, inspiring us with acts of kindness and compassion.

### UPDATE ON COVID RESTRICTIONS FROM BISHOP JOHN SHERRINGTON:

**Funerals:** Funerals can be attended by a maximum of 30 people, and it is advised that only close friends and family attend. Linked ceremonial events such as stone settings and ash scatterings can also continue with up to 15 people in attendance. Anyone working i.e. the priest, cantor, organist, pallbearers, stewards, etc. is not included in the 30.

**Baptisms:** Maximum of 6 including the child to be baptised

**Weddings:** From 2<sup>nd</sup> December weddings can take place in Church with a maximum of 15 people in attendance including the bride and groom.
