# Pope Francis' Prayer for the Year of Mercy

Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us to be merciful like the heavenly Father, and have told us that whoever sees you sees Him. Show us your face and we will be saved.

Your loving gaze freed Zacchaeus and Matthew from being enslaved by money; the adulteress and Magdalene from seeking happiness only in created things; made Peter weep after his betrayal, and assured Paradise to the repentant thief.

Let us hear, as if addressed to each one of us, the words that you spoke to the Samaritan woman: "If you knew the gift of God!"

You are the visible face of the invisible Father, of the God who manifests his power above all by forgiveness and mercy: let the Church be your visible face in the world, its Lord risen and glorified.

You willed that your ministers would also be clothed in weakness in order that they may feel compassion for those in ignorance and error: let everyone who approaches them feel sought after, loved, and forgiven by God.

Send your Spirit and consecrate every one of us with its anointing, so that the Jubilee of Mercy may be a year of grace from the Lord, and your Church, with renewed enthusiasm, may bring good news to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives and the oppressed, and restore sight to the blind.

We ask this through the intercession of Mary, Mother of Mercy, you who live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. **Amen.**

The Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy began with Pope Francis opening the Holy Door in the Vatican on 8<sup>th</sup> **December**. The Cardinal will open the *Holy Door* in Westminster Cathedral in the context of Vespers and Benediction at 3.30pm on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> December. You are very welcome to attend. Those making a brief pilgrimage during the Year to the Cathedral Holy Door or the others through the Diocese may gain the Jubilee Indulgence for themselves or the Holy Souls.

Our closest Holy Door is at St Michael and St Martin, Bath Road, Hounslow TW3 3EH. All are welcome to St Michael & St Martin Church for the **6pm Mass on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December** when Fr Chris as Episcopal Vicar will be opening the Holy Door on behalf of Cardinal Vincent Nichols.

The Cardinal has prepared A *Pilgrimage Companion for the Year of Mercy* by way of explanation and to help us experience God's mercy to the full. As you leave Mass you will be handed one copy of the booklet per family for a donation of  $\pounds 1.00$ . There are also Year of Mercy leaflets and prayer cards available at the back of Church.
