Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Falling out of love can be a very painful experience. Not only for the one who does the falling. But also for the one with whom you have fallen out. But to fall out means that you first fell in! Why do we speak of love as something you fall in, or you fall out? Why don't we jump, or skip, or hop, or slide, or crawl, or simply walk into or out of love? Why do we always have to fall? Many other languages, besides English, have similar expressions that include the notion of "falling", or being "bowed over" by love. Now if human love can bowl you over, what will divine love do?

All the saints fell in love with God. Some fell madly! We also need to fall in love with God. And when we do fall in love with God, it may well have an effect on our body. Be prepared!

Some people, under the influence of God's love, fall down quite literally. Over they go. Flat out. They are "slain in the Spirit". And when they fall, they never seem to get hurt or harmed. Others, deeply touched by God's love, experience a great release of laughter, or are filled with joy, like Saint Philip Neri. Others, like Saint Francis or Saint Ignatius, are frequently moved to tears. Others, like Saint Dominic, groan and sigh. Many great saints, like Saint Teresa of Avila, or Saint Joseph of Cupertino, were forever taking off! Up they would go. Unable to keep their feet on the ground, they levitated all over the shop! BUT, and it is a very big BUT, it is not only love that produces such manifestations. Hysteria can too. Plenty of religious cranks, plenty of holy charlatans and sham saints, go into apparent ecstasy, prophesy, speak in tongues, heal, see visions and hear voices. So how can we tell the difference? How can we discern the manifestations of true holiness and love, from the hysterical, the crazy, the fake? How do we know what is genuine, and what is bogus? How?

Easy! Our all-caring Mother Church guided by the Holy Spirit gives us the *Season of Lent*. Not just one day but forty days beginning on Ash Wednesday. This is the time for us all to fall in love with God. Lent is the perfect time to do this. Lent is a **time of grace**. A time to be set free from all illusions and fantasies about us, and where the Lenten discipline of **prayer, fasting and almsgiving** will help us to discern if our love for God and holiness are authentic so to make us swoon, faint, levitate. Let's then "fall in" this Lent to experience Christ's transfiguring love and mercy. May God bless you.

LENTEN ALMS

"A way has to be found to enable everyone to benefit from the fruits of the earth, and not simply to close the gap between the affluent and those who must be satisfied with the crumbs falling from the table, but above all to satisfy the demands of justice, fairness and respect for every human being." (Pope Francis)

Pope Francis's commitment to the fight against poverty and injustice in all its forms has inspired the Diocese to increase still further the work that it undertakes to support projects which provide practical help to the poor, the hungry, the lonely and the marginalised in our diocese. For this reason, the decision has been taken by Cardinal Vincent and the Archbishop's Council to ask parishioner in every parish in our diocese to consider giving Lenten Alms to Caritas. You will find a leaflet about Caritas and a donation envelope in this newsletter. You are asked to put any money you feel able to give to Caritas – a part of your Lenten alms – into the envelope and return on Holy Thursday or Easter Sunday (completing the Gift Aid Declaration on the back of the envelopes if you are a taxpayer).
