Dear Friends

I was in my dentist's waiting room recently and as there was nothing better to do I browsed the large amount of out of date lifestyle magazines on the coffee table. It then occurred to me that we are subconsciously being led to believe that our modern culture is dependent upon having the latest gadgets and gizmos, or the most beautiful house, or the most expensive car, I could go on and on.

Contrast my dental waiting room experience with today's Gospel. *How happy are you who are poor? Yours is the Kingdom of God.*

A bold statement. Indeed, it could be argued this is a statement that defies common sense, it defies our expectations and it defies our perceived wisdom about how our world works. How can the poor be happy? Of course the reality is more profound than that. There is a sense in which it means to be held in the providential hands of God, to be on the right track and to know the implicit joy of being in such a state in accordance with its potential and promise. Jesus contrasts this in His sermon on the plain, when he says, "But alas for you who are rich: you are having your consolation now." Also in his epistle St. James follows this up with the words,

"Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you. Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten. Your gold and your silver are corroded, and their corrosion will be a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have heaped up treasure in the last days. Indeed, the wages of the labourers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, cry out; and the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth. You have lived on the earth in pleasure and luxury; you have fattened your hearts as in a day of slaughter." James 5:1-9 (New Jerusalem Rible)

Well there are certainly no cosy lifestyle magazines here! Who amongst us wants to be poor, depressed, at war, excluded from society or belittled? Jesus isn't asking us to seek out discomfort, but he is asking us to realise that God always holds a brighter promise for us. If we seek we will find God where we are but we must realise that God calls us further.

God's mercy means doing justice for the poorest and the most humiliated. In his ministry, Jesus met families who were the poorest of the poor. Sadly, we still see poor and powerless people today.

Are we, as his followers, defenders of the poor? What meaningful action could we do either as a community or individually to bring a smile to the lips of someone who is poor or broken? We must accept that unlike the reading of lifestyle magazines Christian living is not an armchair occupation.

It is a true lifestyle choice.
