ADOREMUS: NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS, LIVERPOOL, 7-9 SEPTEMBER 2018 "I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE"



Adoremus is an initiative of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales to create a special opportunity to reflect on the centrality of the Eucharist in the life of the Church. The main base for Adoremus is at the Echo Arena and the BT Convention Centre (ACC Liverpool).

The objectives include rejuvenation of Eucharistic Adoration and to ensure long term benefits in our parishes, schools and communities in terms of catechetical formation and liturgical practice.

On **Friday 7th September** the plan is to offer a Theological Symposium and workshops for better forming Parish catechists (especially First Holy Communion programmes), RE Teachers, Hospital and Prison Chaplains, Seminary Communities and Extraordinary Ministers. The focus of the sessions will be on scripture, ecclesiology, Eucharistic language and Catechism, workshop on the rites and music for Eucharistic Adoration.

The highlight of this weekend will be on **Saturday 8th September** in the Echo Arena where 10,000 pilgrims will gather and will include two keynote speakers, drama highlighting reverence and devotion, music, screen presentations on best practice and the Cardinal will lead us in Adoration.

On **Sunday 9th September** the focus will be on Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral for Pilgrimage Masses (ticketed event) and Street Procession which is open to all.

Attendance on Friday and Saturday is £40 per person per day. Accommodation has to be booked through The Liverpool Convention Bureau who have set aside 2000 rooms for this event. Once we have confirmed numbers we can make the necessary bookings. There is no transport arranged.

There are a limited number of tickets allocated to each parish. If you are interested in attending this event, please speak to Fr John as soon as possible, at the latest by <u>5th March 2018</u>. You can attend any one <u>or</u> more of the three days.

The Diocese has its own Blessed Sacrament Shrine in Covent Garden. Corpus Christi was the first church in England to be dedicated to the Eucharist after the Reformation and has been undergoing extensive restoration. From Easter it will be welcoming pilgrimages from individuals, parishes and schools. The Sodality of the Blessed Sacrament, based at the Church, was established to promote Adoration of, and faith in, the Blessed Sacrament.
