

SYNODAL PATHWAY

We would like to update you since it has been a few months since our Listening Weekend in November. All the responses, from those who came along plus the various parish groups, were collected and sent to Westminster at the end of January. We also had a meeting with Father John and Father Joseph to discuss the responses and how, where possible, they can be implemented here at St Lawrence. This Saturday Cathy, Janet and Father Joseph attended a Pre-Synodal Assembly at Westminster Cathedral along with the other parish representatives in the diocese. Here we shared our parish's experience of the Synodal Pathway so far and reflected on the ongoing journey. We would like to thank you for your support and ask that you continue to make sure that your voice is heard

NEW ARRANGEMENT FOR THE RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

We are so blessed in this parish to have so great a number of parishioners coming to Mass. This new arrangement we shall be introducing is to ensure that people are not walking into one another as they go back to their seats after receiving Jesus in Holy Communion and to do so reverently. From the First Sunday in Lent, when this new arrangement will begin, those sitting on the Baptismal Font side of the church and by the side aisle on Our Lady side of the church will be ushered first to come through the back and down the central aisle and go back through the side aisles. Next will be those sitting on both sides of the main nave of the church coming through the central aisle and going back to their seats through the side aisles. PLEASE wait for the stewards to call you up. For those in the porch and choir loft the arrangement remains the same but please remain in your places and a Minister will come to you.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning on getting married either in this country or abroad a minimum of **SIX MONTHS' NOTICE** is required to process the paperwork. Please do not wait until a month or so before your marriage date, especially those getting married abroad, as the necessary permissions will not reach your destination in time.
