YEAR OF FAITH QUESTION BOX

'Why do Catholic schools not employ Catholic staff?'

Answer: This question seems to suggest that Catholic schools have a problem recruiting Catholic staff (presumably teachers). It is indeed true that recruiting teachers is not an easy task for any school; statistics reveal that up to a third of newly qualified teachers leave the profession within their first few years. The problem becomes more acute in a school which has a distinct ethos or tradition. It would surely be untrue to suggest that head teachers and governing bodies in Catholic schools refuse to appoint Catholics as teachers. Our own school, for example, actively recruits from the Catholic college of St Mary's Strawberry Hill. This is an issue which needs our prayers, but also our action. Are we encouraging our young people to consider teaching as a profession? Do we actively support our teachers in their demanding and vital roles?

'What makes a school Catholic?'

Answer: A school is made Catholic by its tradition and ethos, through the teaching of the Faith and also by the links it maintains with the diocese and parish in which it is located. At the same the time the school community – children, teachers, clergy, ancillary staff, parents, governing body etc – works together to build up the Catholic ethos through worship and the love and care they show for one another. Our Faith should also be visible and audible in our schools – crucifixes, images of the saints, attractive catechetical displays should be apparent along with gracious and careful use of language, and the skilful employment of music and drama. DH.
