*Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,*

When we look at another person, and love that person, we see and love only the goodness and virtue, which that person has **now**, in the present. This is not how God loves. God loves in a very different way. When God looks at you or me, when he loves you or me, he loves all the **potential** in us. He loves us for the person that we **can** become. God loves all the goodness, virtue and holiness that can be born in us, but which, for whatever reason is still in the future, and is not yet present. God loves the **potential** in us for real change, and for true conversion. He loves us for the future relationship that we **can** have with him.

The experience of this kind of love – **unconditional love** – enables me to change and grow and mature; for without this kind of love, I stay as I am. I stay trapped and fixed in my immaturity, my hang-ups, my anxieties and fears. I cannot move on, because my potential for change is not activated. Only this kind of love can activate all the potential in me. And God invites me to love others with exactly the same kind of love. God invites me to love others as he loves me, in their potentiality. This kind of love is called “CARITAS” or “AGAPE”. God wants to give me the capacity to love others like this – especially those close to me, you for instance who are my family.

God calls us once again to **Conversion**. One of its meaning is that when we look into the eyes of another person, and love in that person all the good that is yet to come to birth, then we are loving just as God loves. This is how Christ loved prostitutes, adulterers, thieves, murderers and sinners. This is how He loved Peter, liar and betrayer and all the apostles. This is how He loved Mary Magdalene, Levi, Zaccheus, and Judas too. God calls us to love in the others everything that is negative, broken, wounded, disordered, ugly, everything that, humanly speaking, makes another person unlovable, unacceptable and unforgivable. Yes, we have to love others even in their sin, their lies, their impurity, their laziness, their violence, their anger and their pride. Because this is how God has loved, and continues to love you and me – in our sin. God patiently and hopefully loves all the potential in us for change. Only this kind of love creates the *environment* and the *energy* that makes transformation, growth and change, really possible in our lives. This is the work of the Holy Spirit. It is called “RESURRECTION”! When the Scriptures in today's Mass remind us how much God has loved us – it is this kind of love, this *Caritas*, this *Agape*, that God offers us; and it is this kind of love, which is our deepest need.

#### PARISH PILGRIMAGE - MALTA

#### LOURDES 2014

Fr Chris will be leading a pilgrimage to France by coach for the parishes of Feltham, Heston and Cranford from **19<sup>th</sup> July to 27<sup>th</sup> July**. The price is £699 per person based on two people sharing and includes overnight stays in Paray Le Monial, Poitiers and Lisieux including half board accommodation and visits to local Shrines/Cathedrals. 5 Nights stay in Lourdes on a full board basis, joining the Westminster Lourdes Pilgrimage. *Supplementary charges: Single supplement £230.00 per person, Travel Insurance: £34.00 per person.* Booking forms available from the Parish Office. #### CAR PARK
