

JESUS THE TEACHER

The people constantly question who Jesus is, it's a theme running through St. Mark's Gospel. The people often wonder who this Jesus of Nazareth is. To them Jesus is a mystery.

We are told in today's Gospel that when Jesus explains the scriptures He speaks with authority. His teaching made a deep impression on them. But not only does He teach with authority, He acts with authority, and He has the power to heal the man in the Synagogue. The people are astonished and say 'here is a teaching that is new and with authority behind it.'

When people who have done something, begin to speak, people listen. Their words carry great weight. They have real authority because their words are preceded or followed by good deeds.

'Lord, grant that what we say with our lips, we may believe with our hearts, and practice this in our lives. Amen.'

ROAD AND RAIL DISRUPTION.

British Telecom have started work at the junction of New Road and Hounslow Road.
