JESUS MAKES A DEEP IMPRESSION

One day a young student was walking in the school ground, when he met his favourite teacher, and asked 'how are you?'. The teacher paused for a long moment, thinking about it before replying 'I'm fine thanks for asking'.

At that moment, the student wasn't sure what to make of it. The meeting stayed in his mind for years afterwards. He appreciated that the teacher had thought about his question, and to this day it has made him stop and think every time he asks someone or is asked 'how are you?'

The teacher had taken an everyday question, and everyday language and infused it with new meaning. It made an impression on the young student.

The people who listened to Jesus' teaching in today's Gospel were used to hearing scribes and teachers in the synagogue. But with Jesus they were hearing something new.

We don't know what Jesus was teaching that day, or what kind of language he was using, but what struck the people was that he taught with authority.

Jesus had drawn them in, but they could not quite put their finger on it. 'What does it all mean?' they asked each other. He made them think and they recognised that Jesus was offering something new, something different. Jesus had made a deep impression on them.

'Here is a teaching that is new' they said and with authority behind it. He gives orders even to unclean spirits and they obey him' And his reputation rapidly spread everywhere, through all the surrounding Galilean countryside' (Mk 1:21-28)

UPDATE ON COVID RESTRICTIONS

FROM BISHOP JOHN SHERRINGTON/LOCAL AUTHORITY:

We are now in a national lockdown so please STAY AT HOME. Hounslow has one of the highest rates of the virus.

Places of worship: Open for communal worship or private prayer but people cannot interact with anyone outside household or support bubble.

Please stay at home unless you have to go out. No household mixing aside from support bubbles. If you have had your vaccination, don't think you are safe to go out please stay home for at least the next three weeks or your next dose.

Please remember: Hands, Face, Space:

- Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds

- Wear a face covering in Church and when you come into contact with people you do not normally meet

- Stay 2 metres apart from people you do not live with and you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble

Funerals: Funerals can be attended by a maximum of 30 people, Wakes up to 6 people. Anyone working i.e. the priest, cantor, organist, pallbearers, stewards, etc. is not included in the 30.

Baptisms: Maximum of 6 including the child to be baptised. Currently suspended until further notice.

Weddings: From 20th December weddings are not allowed except in exceptional circumstances.
