Dear Friends,

Last Monday we celebrated the Feast Day of the Conversion of St Paul, Christianity's greatest preacher. St Paul is remembered for many things – the drama of his life-changing conversion, his missionary journeys, his many letters to the Christian communities he helped to plant, his humanity and passionate desire to spread the Gospel, his fearlessness and faithfulness, his martyrdom with St Peter in Rome. In the second reading at Mass today we hear, in Paul's own words, the most beautiful "hymn of love" ever written. It comes from his first letter to the Corinthians, the Christians in Corinth, but over two thousand years later it speaks directly to us. It is a favourite reading at weddings – and increasingly now at funerals. It seems to sum up all we want to say.

But I want to suggest today that it can help each of us personally to make a good examination of conscience and consciousness, inviting us to take a long and loving look at our own lives, our relationships, our values. It helps me examine my heart. Very soon we will be praying for the grace to make a good Lent. One way to make this happen par excellence is the great gift of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I want to suggest to you that it would be wonderful in this Year of Mercy given to us by Pope Francis, if every one of us celebrated the Sacrament for ourselves by making our confession. I believe that once this year is through we would certainly see – and feel – the difference. Keep an eye out in the newsletter for our regular and extra confession times, not just in Lent but throughout the year.

"Blessed are the merciful, for they shall have mercy shown them" (Matthew: chapter 5, verse 7).
