## Happy Holiday Time

It is that time of year again when we all look forward to a summer break. I hope you will get some time to rest and relax over the next weeks and that we get some sunshine!

A few years ago at a meeting in London it came to light that, while many of us look forward to our summer holidays, for many other families, six weeks off school during the summer is a time of anxiety and fear. The only food that some children will eat during the day will be a meal, be that breakfast or lunch, provided at school, no school means no dinner! And for many others, it is not only the lack of food that blights their lives, many will live in a home with parents who, for whatever reason, are unable to provide a stable happy environment for their children. September can't come quick enough for those children; in a society where some have so much, this is a very sad position for any child or parent to be in.

You might be thinking, *'what could I do to help, I have my own family to look after, I have to work, cook and shop.'* And so many other things to juggle, the swimming lessons, the tennis lessons, and the football practice, the list goes on. We know we should *probably* do something, but where would we begin and what could we do, sometimes the stumbling block to helping is simply, *who do I contact.*

Pope Francis calls on **all** Catholics, not just those with a bit of spare time, **'to do more to seek out those on the fringes of society who need help most.'** Here at St.

Lawrence's there are many groups that offer help and support to others. I know many of you are involved with organisations outside the parish offering your time and talents to those less fortunate.

We hope that during the next year we will be able to establish **Caritas St. Lawrence's** and that, by doing so, we will all be able to do more to help those most in need in our parish.

#### ASSISTED DYING BILL - PLEASE WRITE TO A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF LORDS

The Bill to legalise "assisted dying" - meaning assisted suicide - will be debated in the House of Lords on 18th July 2014. There will be a free vote because it is not government legislation. If passed, this Bill would place vulnerable people at serious risk. Especially if you have direct experience of caring for a dying person, either as a family member or as a health or social care professional, please write before 18th July to a Peer to tell them your views.
