A CALL FOR GENEROSITY.

Dearest in the Lord, I wondered how our lives and the entire universe would have been without the spirit of generosity. Notably, being generous is in fact another nature of God. He went into the creation of humanity because he wants us to be partakers of his generous nature. This act was made manifest during the time of creation according to the Scripture, which states that "God made man and woman in their own image and likeness" (Gen.1: 26-27).

Therefore, for God to allow the humankind to be shearers of his nature, is the climax of generosity. However, despite the fact that the early man and woman failed to utilize their opportunity of generosity properly, Eve tried to share her generous gift of apple with her husband, and that led them to the life of disobedience. Yet, God does not abandon them but still gives them privilege to live. At this point, we observed that the act of humans has generated the act of generosity in two dimensions: which includes the positive and negative act of generosity.

Generosity is the willingness to share or to give out whatever gift one has for others. It is wise to remark that, generosity is not limited to the act of giving money or material things as charity, rather it goes beyond. It includes the acts of appreciation, commendation, love, mercy, compassion, and mostly being generous with one's talents, time and knowledge. The act of generosity is positive when we are able to share the above-mentioned gifts with others without leading one to sin and without expectation of reward from them in any kind. Any act of generosity that does not point towards God is a negative act of generosity.

Moreover, the readings of today presented to us the pure acts of generosity by Prophet Elisha, a little boy and Our Lord Jesus himself. Elisha ordered his gifts to be shared among the people (2Kgs.4:42). In the gospel, a little boy submitted his five loaves of bread and two fish to be shared among the multitude of people. He gave out his entire daily meal for the sake of many. What a good heart of generosity. Our Lord Jesus crowned it all by the power of his blessings, feeding the people to their satisfactions.

My beloved in Christ, we are being challenged today to follow up with this call, of being generous with one another no matter the tribe, race or colour, language or country or age, having in mind that we are all made of one Lord, one faith and one baptism (Eph.4:4-6). Thus, it is good to mention that, generosity goes with unimaginable rewards and blessings from God. For instance, people like Abraham entertained unknown visitors (Gen.18:1-15), the woman of Zarephath (1Kgs:17:8-24) etc. Our Lord Jesus, also made clear that the measure one gives is the measure he receives (Mtt.7:2).

I pray that God, out of his mercy and love, will continue to grant us the grace of being generous to one another for the salvation of souls and for our own blessings through Christ our Lord.
