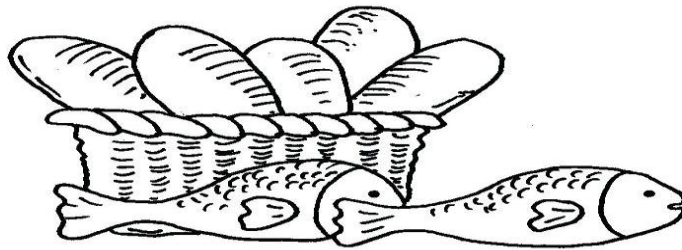

“THE LOAVES AND FISHES”



Have you ever wondered about the young boy in today's Gospel? His mother probably sent him out for some bread and fish, and now he is handing them over, perhaps confused, yet hoping it would do something to help the situation they were in.

It is a powerful gesture and one that reminds us that it is not the size of the gifts or the expectation of return that is important. How must he have felt when he saw the events unfold?

Jesus turns these small resources into something truly amazing. Very often we can react like Andrew and not see the value in small gestures. Jesus satisfies the deep hunger within and shows the crowd that he is someone to hope in.

We must never think that our small resources and gifts are not enough to do amazing things, because everything Jesus wishes to give us, is to be found in one way or another, in and through our celebration and living out of the Eucharist, the Holy Mass.
