This weekend twenty of us from the parish are travelling to Lourdes to join the Westminster Diocesan Pilgrimage. Be assured that we will be praying for you there, lighting candles and remembering you in the holy places. Prayer comes easily in Lourdes, caught up as we are in an atmosphere of prayerfulness. Praying in Lourdes – and being allowed to pray – is as natural as breathing.

Something that was remarked on during our recent Parish Mission "Opening Doors" was just how peaceful and prayerful the Church was, not just during the long times of Eucharistic Adoration throughout the day but before the Masses and services. Let's try and re-capture the sense of our Church as a house of prayer and in our noisy lives, give each other space to find a little peace.
