The Precious Body and Blood of Christ

We will be having a 40 hour Eucharistic Adoration in our parish starting at 7.00am on Friday 29th June and finishing at 11.00pm on Saturday 30th June.

The reason for the 40 hours Adoration is to prepare for the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress in Liverpool which takes place from 7th to 9th September. As a parish it will help us to have a deeper understanding and love of the Eucharist.

During the 40 hours:

- There will be quiet time for prayer and keeping watch.
- There will be Masses and an opportunity for confession.
- The children of St. Lawrence's School will participate.
- The Goan community will lead a time of praise and worship.
- There will be songs and prayer led by the Polish community.
- The Filipino community will keep watch during the night with prayer and devotions.
- There will also be a 'petition box' where you can place your petitions. A selection of these will be read out during the Masses.
- We will be having a 9 day Novena leading up to the 40 hours devotion, so that you can pray at home in preparation for this special event.

A full time table will be published where you can fill in your name when you would like to come and pray during the day or the night.

The Body of Christ makes us a single family, the people of God, reunited around Jesus, the Bread of Life.
