Dear Friends,

I think it fair to state that each of us likes to receive a gift. The joy of receiving something from someone that we love is an emotion that it is difficult to describe using words.

Today is of course Pentecost Sunday. The day on which we Christians celebrate the receiving of the gift of the Holy Spirit by Jesus' disciples. It was a significant moment in time when God broke into humanity to fulfil a promise that Jesus made to his disciples. Jesus knew that the gift of the Holy Spirit was the best gift He could bestow upon them because it was the same Holy Spirit that had guided Jesus throughout his entire life

It shouldn't be any surprise to us that God chose the Feast of Pentecost to gift us the Holy Spirit, because for the Jews the Feast of Pentecost marked another time when God gave us the gift of the Ten Commandments. The Ten Commandments were the laws by which the people of God were to live in relationship with God, their families and society. By following these commandments, the people of God would be an example to others as to how they should conduct their lives.

Therefore, the whole Pentecost tradition includes receiving both the law and the Spirit. Both are given by God to His people to provide direction for their lives. Most of us (who are reading this) would have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit in our Baptism, and the majority of us who are baptised were baptised as infants. Perhaps the unfortunate downside of this is that we have no recollection of that moment when our godparents spoke on our behalf. As a result, we first became acquainted with God's law of love and the Holy Spirit by teachings from our parents, priests, nuns and catechists.

If any of you reading this haven't been Baptised or Confirmed please talk to Fr John in confidence so that we can put in place a programme of events to correct this situation. We are today baptising one adult and confirming another two adults, we are also baptising one baby and one child is receiving her First Holy Communion. It is perhaps appropriate that the gifts of the Holy Spirit will be bestowed on these individuals on Pentecost Sunday.

As Christians, it is incumbent upon us to stand in solidarity with other Christians anywhere in the world. A sign of the Holy Spirit's unity was given to us on that Pentecost Day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples in the form of tongues of fire and each were filled with the Holy Spirit. The passage in Acts tells us that Jews from many different countries who had gathered in Jerusalem to celebrate Pentecost all heard in their own language what the Spirit proclaimed through the disciples.

I'd like to finish by posing a couple of questions. Was the gift that each person heard what was proclaimed in his or her own language? Or was the gift that each individual heard the word of God spoken to him or her directly?
