## THE NEW LECTIONARY AND MASS BOOKS

From the First Sunday of Advent this year, we will start using the new translation of the readings and this means we will have to change the Lectionaries as well as the Parish Mass Books. The new Lectionary will use both the English Standard Version (Catholic Edition) and the Abbey Psalter for the Psalms. The Lectionary is a set of 4 volumes and we are looking to purchase two sets, an Ambo and Chapel edition. We will also be purchasing a Book of Gospels.

We will need to buy Parish Mass Books - 700 copies per liturgical year (total of 2,100 book for the 3 year cycle). This will mean a considerable cost to the parish.

If you would like to contribute towards the purchasing of these Lectionaries and Parish Mass Books you would be very welcome. Those donating towards the Lectionaries your names will be inserted in the Lectionaries.
