“If you are guided by the Spirit you will be in no danger of yielding to self-indulgence...”

This Sunday, the thirteenth in ordinary time of the Church’s liturgical calendar, call to followership and service in the kingdom of God stands out in the first and Gospel readings. However, in all three readings, we see that there can be genuine human challenges to a faithful followership, and even to our desire to give of ourselves in service to God through our brothers and sister in God’s Kingdom.

In the first reading, Elisha is faced with the challenge of leaving his mother and father behind to follow Elijah, the prophet of God. In the Gospel passage also, we see how those whom Jesus called to follow him wanted to attend to the real needs of their families, first. On the face of it, Jesus’ response to their concerns for their families seems inconsiderate. He says: ‘Leave the dead to bury their dead; your duty is to go and spread the news of the kingdom of God.’ and; ‘once the hand is laid on the plough, no one who looks back is fit for the kingdom of God.’ That said, Jesus in fact appreciates the cost of putting God’s calling first before one’s biological family. We can read this in his own family’s experience when he went missing at age twelve and was later found in the Temple. (Lk. 2:41-52) Moreover, he acknowledges that our responsibility to our biological families is in fact divinely mandated. (Mk. 7:9-13)

Besides the obligation to serve God in the lives and needs of our family – the domestic Church, Jesus’ response reminds us that we also belong to the universal family of the Church, - the visible manifestation of God’s kingdom here on earth. The sacred seal of our belonging to and union in the one family of God, we received through our baptism. St Paul puts it more succinctly. “For by one Spirit we were all baptised into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.” (1 Cor. 12:13; cf. Eph. 4:6)

It is not only our worries for the welfare and needs of our individual families that we struggle with. We also have sinful allurements, as well as the present-day threats to our Christian faith getting in the way of living to the full the freedom Jesus Christ won for us through his Passion and death on the cross. As St Paul writes in the second reading, it is only by yielding our lives to and allowing the Holy Spirit to guide us that we can be victorious over these challenges. With his power, we are able to respond faithfully to God who calls us to take part in building up his kingdom in our families, in our parish of St Lawrence and the world at large.
