# THE SOLEMNITY OF THE APOSTLES PETER AND PAUL. GOD DOES NOT CHOOSE US BECAUSE WE ARE GOOD, BUT OUT OF HIS LOVE.

Dearest in Christ, today the Church celebrates the two prominent apostles Saints Peter and Paul. The life of these two men indicated the magnanimity of God's love towards his people, which implies that God chooses from what the world might regard as nothingness to make out something great. Imagine Simon Peter a mere fisherman, a commoner was chosen by Christ (Mk.1:16), also regardless of his denial of Christ in his way to Cross (Matt.26:69-75), he was made the leader of all the apostles and leader of the Church (Jn.21:15-19). Likewise, St. Paul, who was initially called Saul, was a persecutor of Christ's disciples, until he was intercepted on his way to Damascus by Christ himself (Acts.9:1-19). Following the incident of his conversion, he became the most outstanding preacher and sufferer of the gospel (2Cor.11:23-27). These two apostles were able to remain constant in proclaiming the gospel notwithstanding many oppositions from Jews and enemies of their time. Above all, they welcomed to shed their blood for the sake of the gospel.

My dear brothers and Sisters in the Lord, we are the apostles and the disciples of Christ in this modern era. We are notably the chosen ambassador of Christ, whom the Lord has given the authority and mandate to go into the world and proclaim the good news. God has chosen us despite our unworthiness, and has empowered us. We might encounter many obstacles while trying to put our life's gospel into practise, but with consistency in prayer and trusting in the power of the word of God, we shall win the glorious crown.

Finally, Saints Peter and Paul allowed God to use them as a vital instrument for evangelisation of the whole nation. We as well are the chosen race of Christ; therefore, we are encouraged to recognise our God's precious privileges, utilise it wisely for the sake of the kingdom of God and salvation of souls.

Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us.

# THE NEW LECTIONARY AND MASS BOOKS

From the First Sunday of Advent this year, we will start using the new translation of the readings and this means we will have to change the Lectionaries as well as the Parish Mass Books. The Lectionary is a set of 4 volumes and we are looking to purchase two sets, an Ambo and Chapel edition. We will also be purchasing a Book of Gospels.

We will need to buy Parish Mass Books - 700 copies per liturgical year (total of 2,100 book for the 3 year cycle). This will mean a considerable cost to the parish.
