Meditate

Jesus is shown today in his most human side, crying at the death of a friend as well as giving reassuring words to those who had gone through bereavement. There are different attitudes toward him, some are cynical (he could have done something earlier) others acknowledge his care for Martha and Mary. However, the greatest miracle is faith, and trust in God.

Act

Jesus went to console his friends in a moment of bereavement. All of us are surrounded by someone who has lost a loved one. Approach them and following Jesus' example be with them, sharing in their pain and speaking if you feel it is necessary.

Spiritual Communion

My Jesus,
I believe that you are present in this Holy Sacrament of the altar.
I love you above all things and I passionately desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, come spiritually into my soul so that I may unite myself wholly to you now and forever. Amen
