

## Dear Friends

It is my pleasure this weekend to launch the "**Proclaim** '15" initiative in the parish. We are invited to be a part of this national programme throughout the Catholic Church of supporting, enthusing and equipping parish evangelisation, of helping us grow as a missionary parish. The inspiration for this initiative is the beautiful letter from Pope Francis, "The Joy of the Gospel". In this letter the Holy Father writes: "I wish to encourage the Christian faithful to embark upon a new chapter of evangelisation marked by this joy, while pointing out new paths for the Church's journey in years to come."

So how are we going to begin to take up this invitation? On the weekend 6th/7th, 13th/14th and 20th/21st June there will be special inserts in the newsletter, each one helping us discover what it means to live as, in the words of Pope Francis, "missionary disciples". During the week that follows each of the three weekends we are inviting you to meet in a group for an hour or so, to reflect on that insert from the newsletter and maybe even to organise a group in your own home, inviting your family, friends and neighbours along. One thing is for sure, it will be a great opportunity to get to know each other better – and that has to be a good thing.
