PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

Thank you for the wonderful International Mass last Sunday. It was both moving and uplifting, and as I said at the end of Mass, now is a good time for us to form our Parish Pastoral Council. The last time we met was before Covid times.

Baptism calls all of us to serve in new ways and to get involved in the life of our parish. The Parish Pastoral Council can be a channel for bringing us together and providing good communication between the different groups and communities, here in St. Lawrence's. It is also in response to our parish Synodal Pathway we held some time ago.

Pope Frances has called for a Jubilee/Holy Year in 2025. He says the coming Jubilee will be a Holy Year marked by the hope that does not fade, our hope in God. I am sure the new Pastoral Council will take a leading role in the life of our parish in the coming Jubilee year. Please do speak to me or one of the Parish Team if you are interested. It would be good to have it in place before the summer holidays.

THE NEW LECTIONARY

On the 1st Sunday of Advent this year the new Lectionary will become mandatory in all Catholic parishes and Mass Centres throughout England, Wales and Scotland. The Lectionary, which is the book that contains the Scripture Readings for Mass and the Sacraments, is changing as part of the continuing process of revising liturgical translations. The new Lectionary will use both the English Standard Version (Catholic Edition) and the Abbey Psalter for the Psalms. This will mean a considerable cost to the parish and if you would like to contribute towards the purchasing of these Lectionaries you would be very welcome, and your names will be inserted in the Lectionaries.

On this Feast of the Most Holy Trinity the Cardinal in his pastoral letter says:

"In this great feast we can grasp the richness and beauty of our faith: the majesty of God (Father) into whose presence we are called, the vitality of the Holy Spirit stirring in us the possibility of holiness and the strength of Jesus (Son) given to us in the Most Holy Eucharist. This is a cause of great joy, to be shared by all the people, with your children, with your neighbours, at any time and in any place"
