Dear Friends

To mark the Year of Faith we are restoring a beautiful old custom, the annual Forty Hours Devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. This begins on Thursday, the traditional feast of Corpus et Sanguis Christi (the Body and Blood of Christ), which is now transferred to next Sunday, and runs through to the following Monday. The Forty Hours comprises three Masses a day on Thursday, Friday and Monday (9.30am, 12.15pm and 7.30pm), Eucharistic Adoration following the morning Mass through to the evening, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament to conclude our 11am Mass on Sunday and joining in a Worldwide Holy Hour in union with Pope Francis at 4pm that afternoon. All in all, a time of rich devotion to Our Lord, present for us in the Blessed Sacrament, and a chance for us to spend quality time in His beautiful presence. My hope and prayer for our Forty Hour Devotion this year is that it will be for each of us a time of renewal and of deep prayer as we enter the depths of Our Lord's profound and personal love for us.
