What does it mean for us to believe in a God who sees all of us as alive?

Today's Gospel raises the question for us of what it means to know and worship God who is *'God, not of the dead, but of the living.'* In this month of November, we remember and pray for our dead, all those friends and family members who have gone before us. By faith we acknowledge that they are now with God in heaven, and our hope is that we may one day, by the grace of God, be re-united.

We feel their absence keenly, and wish to see them again. We reassure ourselves of their nearness. For example, a well-known poem describes the dead as *'in the next room'*. This is a lovely image of being near, but it also stresses their absence: we may go into that room, but our dearly departed will slip away unseen, into the next one.

In Matthew's Gospel, when Jesus died on the cross we are told that *'at that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.'* That curtain divided people from the presence of God in the Holy of Holies, that is, the space behind the curtain.

In this place, the ark of the covenant rested in dark and silence, until, on only one day each year, the high priest came with blood from the atoning sacrifice offered for the people, and sprinkled it on the ark. Then he would withdraw, and the ark symbolising God's presence existing in the covenants made with the Jewish people, would return to its dark isolation.

In being one of us, a human being, Jesus broke the division between God and us. But he went even further. By entering into death, he, the Living One, destroyed it. Now neither death nor life can separate us from the love of God – Jesus Christ. The reality of this is perfected in the Holy Eucharist, where we share in the Love which conquers death.

Therefore, at every Mass, let us remind ourselves to live each moment of each day with this life. Then we will be more intimately united with all our loved ones who are also united with Christ. Even though we cannot see them: they are closer to us now than ever before: the veil has been torn down.
