Jesus wants us to treat everyone we meet with sensitivity and generosity. Today's Gospel reminds us of our responsibility to care for other people, the hungry, the stranger, those who are without, the sick and the imprisoned.

There are simple acts of kindness we can do each day. Such love for others is love for God; as the Gospel tells us: 'In so far as you did this to the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me'.

Charles de Foucault spoke of 'seeing Jesus in every person and consequently treat each one as an equal and as a brother or sister, but also with great humility, respect and selfless generosity'.

When we face trials and pains in our lives we should always remember that we are never abandoned because Jesus, the Servant King is there with us always. He is on the cross with us telling us, 'Do not be afraid, I have conquered all things'.
