## First Sunday of Advent

Dear Friends

Advent is a time that helps us to find out about ourselves, to find out what it is that is important to us, and what occupies the thoughts of our hearts from day to day. Advent is a time of **hope**.

The first candle on the Advent wreath is the **Candle of Hope**. When you pray at home each day this week, you can pray the following prayers:

We light this candle today to remind us that Jesus is our hope and the hope of the world. We thank God for the promises he has made to us and for the light he has brought into the world. (First Candle is lit)

Hope is like a light shining in the dark place. As we look at the light of this candle we celebrate the hope we have in Jesus Christ.

Lord God, only you can see into my heart and know that under all the busyness of my life, there is a deep longing to make this Advent one that welcomes you more deeply into my own life. (Your personal intentions) Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be Come, Lord Jesus, Come.

Earlier in the year you will (hopefully) remember that we were working on a **Helping Hands Project** in the parish.
