We are called to be persistent in prayer. The Parable of the Persistent Widow.

Jesus uses this parable to teach us never to give up. He shows us the importance of persistence and resilience. Jesus knows that life involves disappointment, loss, injustice, and persecution all very good reasons to give up and lose hope! But life attuned to God's presence, justice and goodness is a life that can endure.

This widow's persistence illustrates our need to pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Prayer changes us more than it changes the people around us. It deepens our faith and trust in God and empowers us to wait with hope for God to act. This gospel passage challenges us not just to pray but to trust in God.

'Ask and you shall receive'. Let us reflect on our lives and what has been our experience of asking God for what we want and what we need, for our part how aware are we of God always being predisposed to loving and caring for us? We pray that this attitude of being loved and cared for is always present in our heart when we ask for what we want or need.

YOU DON'T PAY MORE TAX IF YOU GIFT AID

Instead, the Government adds 25% of your donation and gives it to the Church.

If you pay by contactless machine, you can Gift Aid your donation. The first time you use your card, click yes for Gift Aid and put in your contact details to register as a Gift Aider. This information is stored internally and every time you use that card on the machine it automatically recognises you as a Gift Aider. If you use another card, you would have to key in Gift Aid details again. This also applies if there are two or more machines in the Church and you use a different one the second time, you would have to key in your details. *You can only Gift Aid if you are a UK Tax payer and you have paid the same amount or more in Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax in that tax year.*
