Dear Friends

This weekend we celebrate Mothering Sunday, a day to be really and truly thankful for the beautiful gift of God in creation of motherhood and for our own mother's love. Mums – you deserve it!



The Church invites us today to reflect a little on three God-given aspects of Motherhood: First, on human motherhood itself. Every child has the right to call someone "Mum", either biological or adoptive. This is why the traditional understanding of motherhood, fatherhood, parenthood, family and marriage matters so much. Secondly, on the motherhood of Mary, Mother of Christ and mother of us, the Church. Standing at the foot of the Cross on the first Good Friday, Mary is given a second son, John the Beloved Disciple, and John is given a new Mother. John stands for us. Just as Mary held Jesus in her tender, strong and loving arms, so she holds us as her own beloved children. Finally, on the motherhood of our Holy Mother, the Church. Blessed John Paul II wrote a beautiful letter, Ecclesia: Mater et Magister, that is, the Church, Mother and Teacher. It is in Mother Church that we are brought to new birth, nurtured, fed, nourished, taught, healed and brought to maturity as beloved sons and daughters. So much to be thankful for today.

May God Bless all mothers, here and in eternity. To all of them – to all of you – thank you.
