Dear Friends

From this weekend many of the prayers we pray and responses we make at Mass will be from the new translation of the Roman Missal for the English speaking world, in preparation for its complete introduction on Advent Sunday. Mass hasn't changed – indeed it is in many ways a fuller and richer and more faithful translation of the post-Vatican II Liturgy – but it will sound subtly different. Change is always challenging – changing schools, jobs, homes, neighbours, translations of the Bible, even changing priests. Sometimes change happens for very good reasons, and this is certainly true in the changes to how we celebrate and pray our Mass. The language we use at Mass, liturgical language, tries to find and express the least inadequate words to speak to God, to speak about God and the things of God. Much of the language we use in the new translation is more sacramental, more sacred and more obviously springing from Sacred Scripture. It is the same Mass, just more heartfully and poetically experienced and expressed. A really useful guide to the new translation is on sale in the porch after Mass this weekend, "Understanding the Revised Mass Texts", price just £1.00.

The next few months at Mass will be interesting to say the least!

To help them nurture the faith of these children we have a term-time Sunday School between the morning Masses, offering instruction in the Catholic faith to children 6 years or older attending non-Catholic schools.
