## **Quo Vadis Fr John Louis Tabor September 2019**

I am very pleased to be able to introduce myself to you, both in person over these coming weeks and by means of a short introduction on the newsletter.

It is a real privilege to have been asked by the Cardinal to Feltham. It is a vibrant and diverse parish and I am looking forward to getting to know you as we accompany each other on this adventure in Christian living. This is my second appointment; my first was at Northfields in Ealing, a rather smaller parish than Feltham. I was ordained in 2018, having studied for four years at the Pontifical Beda College in Rome. Previously I had worked in a number of roles in the financial services in City for just over 10 years. I am a Westminster man born and bred, having entered this world in the Westminster Hospital. When I was four my father's work took us as a family to the West Country, so we swapped city life for the wilds of Exmoor – something of a contrast!

I went to school at Downside in Somerset and my time there sowed the seeds of my priestly, if not monastic, vocation. I am still in regular touch with the community there and with its daughter house, Ealing Abbey. I studied Classsics at Royal Holloway, which is not far from here at Egham – little did I think when I was there in the early 1990's that I would one day return here as a priest in this parish!

Even after school and university, thoughts of a possible vocation persisted. Part of this I think is due to my going to Lourdes each year (and sometimes more than once) from the age of 18, firstly with the Order of Malta Volunteers (OMV) and then with the Diocese. The example of selfless giving, both of helpers and malades and the real joy I experience there is a touch of the Divine. Meanwhile I had a good job and nice life in London. It all looked on the surface very good, very conventional. Still there was something missing. Finally, after a couple of false starts, I heeded the advice of a good Priest friend who advised me with the memorable words "Get on with it and go and see the Vocations Director"!

After two ears of further discernment and various selections processes and procedures, the Cardinal accepted me for priestly formation in March 2014 and I went to Rome that autumn to begin studies. The seminary was a privileged time of growth, especially in the practice of prayer and self-awareness, as well as mixing with a really interesting group of people drawn from a mix of countries and cultures. I am incredibly grateful to the Cardinal for his kindness and wisdom in sending me there. MY priestly ordination along with five others in the Cathedral was a deeply moving moment – both the culmination and start of something wonderful – a call to loving service.

Now I am here with you – and I am sure that it will be a time of hard work, but with great rewards too as we build up the Church in this place.
