Dear Friends

I wonder how many of you have ever been lost. I know that I have, both actually lost in a foreign city and spiritually lost on my own personal pilgrimage of life. It might be fair to say that in both situations but in different ways I had lost my way. These days it's too easy to lose our way, and sadly the reality of our contemporary era is that we don't have to look too far, (and indeed sometimes we need only look at ourselves), to see people worshipping their pop idols or sporting team or shopping for things that they have no need of.

In today's First Reading the Israelites had certainly lost their way. These people, who had been freed from slavery by the mercy of God, repaid God's infinite mercy by worshiping a calf they themselves had made from molten metal. The theme of God's mercy is continued in the Psalm and in the Second Reading. I sometimes think that we as a Catholic community don't reflect upon the psalms in a prayerful way, perhaps just seeing it as a musical interlude between the two readings, but todays psalm with its theme of mercy is an appropriate link between the two readings and the Gospel.

The irony of today's Gospel is that mercy isn't mentioned at all. We have three parables, the last one "The Parable of the Prodigal Son" is probably among the best known parables in the New Testament. This reveals to us that the theme of today's Gospel is mercy. Mercy is what motivated the father to forgive his son. Only when the younger son was at his lowest ebb did he think of returning to his father's house. The younger son was both the lost sheep and the lost drachma and the joy that was felt by the father was the same joy that was experienced by both the shepherd and the woman in the earlier parables. Similarly, the Israelites in the desert were at a low ebb and indeed so was St Paul before his conversion as he illustrated for us when he said to Timothy that his behaviour towards Christians was because of his ignorance of the mercy of God received through Our Lord Jesus Christ.

And so it must be with each and every one of us. We are, all of us at times lost, we are, all of us at times prone to behaviour such as pride, self-assurance and dare I suggest even arrogance. But like the Israelites in the desert, St Paul and the Prodigal Son, we must always be ready to embrace God's mercy and be reborn into a new life reconciled to God.
