Dear Friends,

Autumn is of course a time of change. The most obvious being that the leaves are falling from the trees and the days becoming shorter and cooler. Some of our youngest parishioners will be starting school for the first time and our older children will be restarting school in a new academic year. Many of our young adults will soon be starting university or perhaps beginning a new career if they have finished their formal education.

Here at St Lawrence's we will also be undergoing change as this weekend Fr John is leaving us to take up his new appointment as Parish Priest in Tring and Fr Mike Maguire is coming to be our new Parish Priest. Please remember them both in your prayers as they embark on their new ministries.

Fr John certainly cared about the people that God cares about and I am certain that Fr Mike will too, but if all of us claim to have faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ, then that means that all of us must live our faith and care about the people that God cares about. In today's psalm, we read that God cares about the poor, the hungry, the imprisoned, the blind, crushed and the oppressed. God loves them all and he protects the stranger. In the light of the recent rioting in many parts of the UK, now might be a good time to ask myself what attitudes do I have to immigrants and asylum seekers? Some of the rioters claimed to be Christian, although I must admit I'm not sure how they can reconcile such extreme views about people from a different culture with the ministry of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

In today's gospel Mark tells us that there is more than one way of being deaf or blind. I think that from time to time we all need to ask ourselves whether we are deaf or blind or both. That could be deaf and blind to the wonder all around us, for example, the changing seasons and the development of our young parishioners as they continue their educational and spiritual journeys; but also to how much we are loved by others or how deaf and blind we might be to those who God has sent to help us or those that God is sending us to help.
