Amen. Dear Friends,

As we prepare for Advent, now might be a good time to reflect on the past year and look forward to the next.

This year on the First Sunday of Advent the new Lectionary will come into use at all parishes in England, Wales and Scotland. However, some things remain the same and we will still hear the Gospel of Luke in the coming year.

Luke's Gospel has often been called "the most beautiful book in the world." Its Christmas stories and the parables of the Prodigal Son and the Good Samaritan have captured the hearts of the Christian world. In particular, Luke emphasises about the part women played in the early years of the church. For example, John the Baptist's mother Elizabeth and the Christmas story involving Mary. Luke also has special concern for the poor and the humble.

But, it would also be true to state that a prominent theme of Luke's Gospel is the doctrine of repentance and forgiveness. Jesus instructed his disciples to forgive one another, and he gave us a vivid example when, from the cross, he said, *"Father forgive them they do not know what they are doing"*. Also, Peter was forgiven after he denied Christ three times. So perhaps with this theme of forgiveness, now might be a good time to consider that if you haven't received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for a while then please take the opportunity to do so during Advent.
