Dear Friends

I realise that I have said this many times, but being a Christian is challenging and being a Catholic Christian is particularly challenging. Throughout the year there is no more challenging time to us than our personal Lenten journey. We all get tired, I am sure that there are times when we have all dozed off during Mass and even our Catholic faith can seem a bit routine and even boring.

On Ash Wednesday, we began our Lenten journey with a firm commitment to pray more deeply, fast more faithfully and to give alms more generously. But for our political leaders, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving somehow have become less appealing than arguing with one another about who is the greatest or whose country is the greatest, whose candidate, whose policies, whose ideologies etc....

Sadly, there is still war. There are still refugees. There is still racism. But because Jesus' name is above every other name, because we bend our knee before him and confess him as our Lord, we will be obedient to him. We will carry the cross that Jesus that has given us.

We are indeed God's people who will see, and one day share, in the glory of the risen ascended Christ.

LOURDES 2025 - BOOKINGS OPEN!

I am delighted to announce that the booking system for our diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes is now open. To book yourselves, please use the following steps:

Access the website via https://pilgrimages.rcdow.org.uk/ Read the information, then click 'l'm ready to complete the form now', and follow the instructions.

Please choose the 'Feltham – 6 day' as the name of the parish, travelling by air, and staying at the Hotel Padoue.

Initially, you will pay your £50 diocesan levy online, then Tangney Tours will invoice you for the remainder of the costs. For our parish, Flights and accommodation at the Padoue will cost £1,081, with a single room supplement of £210, or you can share with another pilgrim without paying this supplement. We hope to do some fundraising to bring this cost down as much as possible. For the booking you will need details of your General Practitioner and details of illness/medication, as well as payment for the £50 diocesan levy. You will need a valid Passport and EHIC/GHIC Health Insurance Card to complete the booking, and for travel to Lourdes, please bring these with you also. Again, if you need assistance with this, Fr Mike will be able to help.
