## SAINT OF THE WEEK

St Margaret Clitherow (1556-1586) Martyr, 26<sup>th</sup> March *"I believe that whatever comes at a particular time is a blessing from God."*  Two weeks ago I had the privilege of accompanying four of our Catechumens and Candidates to the Rite of Election at Westminster Cathedral, as they, with hundreds of others, took a considerable stride towards Full Communion with the Catholic Church. The Candidates, who are seeking to complete their initiation into the Church, not only expressed their desire to 'live out their discipleship within the visible communion of the Church', but they were each invited by Cardinal Vincent to always 'hear the Lord's call to conversion and be faithful to their baptismal covenant'; an invitation extended to all the baptised at the beginning of this Lenten season. Then the Catechumens declared their desire to be baptised and received into Full Communion with the Church by publicly responding to the call of Christ, from which the Church, in the name of Christ, calls them to the Easter sacraments. Their names were then entered into a book which was placed at the side of the baptismal font, so that everyone who passes by it may read the names and pray for them as they make the final journey towards the Easter sacraments. What struck me were the phrases 'to hear' and 'to respond' to the 'call' of Christ, emphasising that each of us is called, personally, by the Lord to make up the *Body* of Christ, the Church, to go and bear fruit. Thus, Lent is truly connected to baptism, and the liturgies throughout Lent take us on a baptismal journey. For those of us who have already been baptised, Lent is a time when we are called to walk with the Catechumens, from which we rediscover our own call to baptism. On the 1st Sunday of Lent, we read of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness, and the specific 'call' for each of us was to renew our attachment to God as we face the struggles and temptations in our own lives; for at baptism we were grafted onto Jesus. Last weekend our readings spoke of Abraham, our Father in Faith, and the Transfiguration, teaching us to place our trust in God as we travel through Lent. The Transfiguration of Christ gives us a foretaste, a glimpse, of the destination where our baptismal journey takes us. St John Henry Newman sums up well the relationship between Lent and baptism, for he says, 'during Lent, we should confess our sins, so that we can live out our baptism more fully and receive the Eucharist more worthily.'

For our parish, Flights and accommodation at the Padoue will cost £1,081, with a single room supplement of £210, or you can share with another pilgrim without paying this supplement.
