Dear Friends,

It's challenging to be a Christian and particularly challenging to be a Catholic Christian. Some people find it isn't easy to do what's right, especially in the moments when doing what is right does not align with the majority opinion. It seems to me that, often, it can be perceived as being far easier to go along with the crowd, accepting things as just the way things are. So, as the crowd in today's Passion Gospel shout "Hosanna", do we shout "Hosanna"? As the crowd screamed "Crucify him", what do we scream? The history of our Church, from the time of Jesus to the present day, has been filled, and continues to be filled, by the witness of Saints and Martyrs who didn't simply accept the social and personal status quo of their times as just "the ways things are". Instead they followed the way of Jesus, which, for many, led them to Martyrdom. This 'Holy Week', especially, we are called to follow Jesus more closely - to watch Him, to listen to Him, to learn from Him, and to stand with Him, as a witness to all that Jesus has done and continues to do for us. In many ways this helps us to stand out from amongst the crowd, as we courageously and joyfully bear witness to our Catholic Christian identity. May this Holy Week offer us the opportunity to "immerse ourselves in the central events of Redemption, and to relive the Easter Mystery, the great Mystery of our faith" (Pope Benedict XVI), beginning this Palm Sunday as we take our place amongst the crowds, waving our palms and crying out, "Hosanna! Blessings on him who comes in the name of the Lord." Let's not view this Holy Week from afar, rather, come and step into the mystery and dramatic reality that is our Redemption.

Have a blessed and prayerful Holy Week.
