ST FLORIAN (250-304)

Feast Day: May 4; Patron of Firemen & Chimney Sweeps "Compassion is the greatest gift you can give to someone in need."

# Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

John 21:1–19 is a deeply moving and symbolic passage that highlights restoration, calling, and love. After His resurrection, Jesus appears once again to His disciples by the Sea of Tiberias. The scene begins with a miraculous catch of fish, mirroring an earlier moment in Jesus' ministry (Luke 5:1–11), reminding the disciples—and us—of their original calling and His power to provide.

Peter's actions stand out. He leaps into the sea to meet Jesus, a sign of eagerness and perhaps unfinished business. Just days earlier, Peter had denied Jesus three times. Now, around a charcoal fire—a deliberate echo of the fire near which Peter denied Him—Jesus gently confronts him. Three times He asks, "Do you love me?" and three times Peter responds, each time followed by a commission: "Feed my lambs," "Tend my sheep," "Feed my sheep."

This repetition isn't to shame Peter but to restore him. Jesus doesn't scold or punish. Instead, He reaffirms Peter's worth and purpose, entrusting him with care for the community. It's a powerful reminder that failure does not disqualify us from serving God—repentance and love can lead to restoration and a renewed calling.

Jesus' final words to Peter, "Follow me," bring the passage full circle. Despite the pain of his denial, Peter is invited once again into intimate discipleship. These words also challenge us. Following Jesus means embracing grace, carrying responsibility, and being willing to love and serve, even after failure.

Ultimately, this passage is about mercy and mission. It shows that Jesus meets us in our brokenness, restores us through love, and calls us into lives of purpose and service. In Peter's journey, we see our own: broken but called, forgiven and sent.

#### SATURDAY MORNING CHANGES

Eucharistic Adoration will take place from 9am-10am on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> May. Confession will be from 9.30-10.30am. PRIEST TRAINING FUND - Next Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday, the day we pray for priests and for vocations to the priesthood. The annual collection for the Priest Training Fund will take place next weekend. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 50 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 13 of whom are from our own Diocese. 2 of these are deacons for Westminster. We also have 2 seminarians at the Royal English College in Valladolid. Last year 3 deacons who studied at Allen Hall were ordained priests. It costs on average £25,000 per man, per year of formation. This fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests. Your generous donation helps ensure we can support these men who are called to be like Christ the Good Shepherd. Donation envelopes are available in the back of the church. Please take one home, read the information, and bring it back next weekend with your donation. Please continue to pray for vocations and for our priests. You can use the QR code (on the poster in the porch) to make your donation online or visit www.rcdow.org.uk/donations.
