**Dear Friends,**

I write this on Tuesday 6th May as the cardinal electors from around the world prepare to retreat to the Sistine Chapel in the Vatican on Wednesday 7th May to begin the process of selecting the next pope. Personally, I find it comforting that more than ever before their ranks will mirror the changing global demographics of our Roman Catholic Church.

Sadly, in recent years, there has been a decline in the number of European Catholics, but equally true is that Catholic populations have grown Latin America, Asia and particularly in Africa. Vatican statistics are stating that at the beginning of the 20th century less than 1% of Catholics lived in Africa, now that figure is around 16%, which is a similar proportion as Europe. I guess that like most of us, I am wondering who the next pope will be. I suspect by the time of reading this question will have been answered. Fortunately for us, we don't need to be sure about the answer because the promises about what will be, are already being fulfilled. Our Lord Jesus Christ has already been glorified.

Each time we attend Mass, we will all share in the Eucharist and in doing so we share in his triumph. He is already calling each of us to accept the controlling power of his love in our lives. Often, we can find big, sudden changes distressing. But through scripture, God reminds us that he is with us through it all, and no matter how far or near we might be, he will always come to find us to bring us back to himself.

Before he was named Pope Francis, the then Archbishop of Buenos Aires, Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio gave a short speech to other cardinals before the start of the 2013 conclave, in which he called for the church "to come out of herself and to go to the peripheries." Please join me in prayer that the next successor to St Peter, whoever he is, will continue to be a product of that vision.

The fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests.
