CATECHESIS CORNER

Last week, we went into detail about the significance of the lit candle used during baptism. We will discuss the significance of the white garment this week. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (Number 1243) states: The white garment symbolises that the person baptised has 'put on Christ', has risen with Christ… Thus, the white garment is an external manifestation of the individual's Christian dignity. It also means that the baptised has been clothed with Christ and is now a new creation. Despite having dignity when they were created, humans lost it due to original sin; nonetheless, baptism restores it. That is why the Priest or Deacon says these words before clothing the baptised with the white garment:

.... you have become a new creation and have clothed yourself in Christ. See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity... Our Christian dignity is holiness of life. Accordingly, God gives all Christians instructions in 1 Peter 1:15–16, Just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy.
