CATECHESIS CORNER

'We are both chosen and strengthened by the Holy Spirit to meet all the challenges that life presents us with and to use our gifts and talents for the building of God's kingdom,' (Fr Eddie McGhee) is one of my favourite descriptions of the place and effect of Confirmation for our Christian journey. In this we can see that the sacrament of confirmation 'focuses on the giftedness of those who have been baptised' - it completes baptism (Youth Catechism 203) - in which confirmation candidates receive the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. Can you name these seven gifts? Answers are at the end of this text. Remember, God gives us 'freedom', especially the freedom to choose. In the Catechism (1743) it states 'God willed that man should be left in the hands of his own counsel, so that he might of his own accord seek his creator and freely attain his full and blessed perfection by cleaving to him.' Here we can understand how we are given the 'freedom to act or not to act' and that 'freedom attains perfection in its acts when directed towards God' (CCC 1744), but it also draws us to a great truth that 'for freedom Christ has set us free' (CCC 1748). So, 'anyone who freely decides to live a life as God's child and asks for God's Spirit [through confirmation] receives the strength to witness to God's love and might in word and deed' (Youth Catechism 203). If you are an adult and have not been confirmed, I encourage you to consider preparing for this sacrament, both in your freedom to choose, the freedom that God gives us, and in our confession that 'Yes, I believe in you, my God; give me your Holy Spirit' (Youth Catechism 205). The 7 Gifts of the Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Courage, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord.
